Thesis Ownership & Access

- Where questions of the confidentiality of the contents arise, candidates may request and obtain temporary restriction of access (PGR8) up to a maximum of four years for sufficient cogent reasons. An application for the restriction of access must be approved and countersigned by a research student's principal supervisor. The period of restriction will commence based on the time of publication by the library. This time normally commences following the conferral of the candidates' award.
