1. Information Points

The Open Day information area is located in the library (see campus map). Look out for our DCU Student Ambassadors (wearing "Can I Help?") red high vis jackets and members of staff who will be happy to help.

2. Parents/Guardians Talk

Do you have questions about university? About how to offer support and advice during the application process and after enrolment. Join us for a special session with Student Support and Development in room D211 at 11.15am.

3. Course Presentations

Presentations will cover course content, choices within degrees, differences between similar degree courses, placements and career prospects. Each presentation will be approximately 30 minutes in duration. So, for example, if you are interested in attending the Bachelor of Education talk, go to room G114 in the G Block at 10am or 12pm.

4. University Taster Sessions

There will be three Taster Sessions taking place on Primary placement, Post Primary placement and an interactive session on STEM in early education. We would encourage you to attend the session relevant to the course or courses you are interested in.

5. Graduate Panel with Q&A Session

We are hosting a Graduate Panel with Q&A session on St Patrick's campus. Hear from recent DCU Graduates talk about their university experience and career development since graduation. 6. Campus Tours

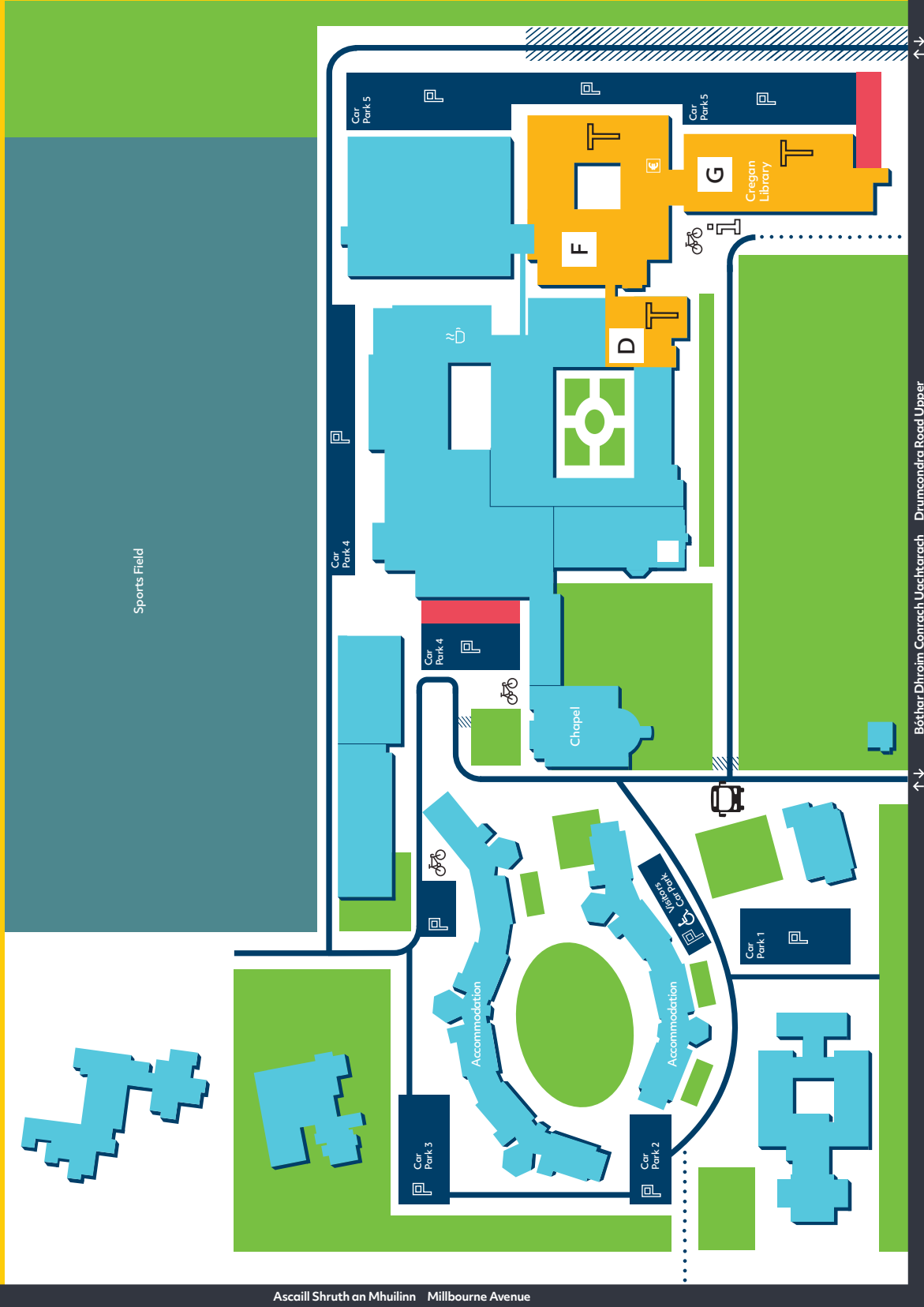
