

## Assembly (5<sup>th</sup> and 6th Class)

### Based on Term 2 Lesson 3 Fit for Life

#### Jesus healed

**Songs:** Jesus hands were kind hands, Brother sister let me serve you

**You need:** to have taught Lesson 3 Jesus healed  
Have prepared a dramatic presentation of the 'parable of soup' and/or one of the Bible stories

Have a discussion about inclusion and who might be considered outcasts in society today – be sensitive to local/ family contexts.

Pupil 1	Last week in R.E. we talked about sick people who Jesus healed
Pupil 2	We talked about when we were sick or injured
Pupil 3	We learned about a disease that was very common in the time of Jesus
Pupil 2	It was called leprosy
Pupil 3	People suffered very badly when they had the disease. As well as being in pain and sick they had to live away from their families and friends so they didn't pass it on. They couldn't work and couldn't earn money.
Pupil 1	We read some stories from the Gospel of Luke in the Bible. Luke was a doctor so there are lots of stories about sick people in his book.
Story	Choose one of the two stories to read
Pupil 1	There is a cure for leprosy today so people don't suffer in the same way as in Bible times.
Pupil 4	We also read other stories about Jesus healing people.
Story/ Drama	You might like to present a short version of one of the two stories from days 2 /3
Pupil 1	We thought about how Jesus helped people who were outcasts, people others didn't care about or want to touch.
Pupil 4	An outcast is someone who can be seen as being on the outside of everyone else. We thought of examples of people who might be seen by some as outcasts.
Pupil 5	We thought of (your classroom discussion may have raised current situations of concern to the class - you may think about homeless/ people who are living in and

	<i>going to school from hostels or hotels, people living in refugee camps) You could have some newspaper cuttings or headlines printed on card. You can focus on local or international.</i>
<b>All</b>	Present the modern 'Parable of soup'. Explain this is not a Bible story.
<b>Prayers</b>	These prayers can include prayers for people who are sick or for others in society/ the world who need help. <b><i>Include the prayer of the week.</i></b>

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
