

# 'Accommodating User Needs for ISO 704: Towards a New Revision of the Core International Standard on Terminology Work'

## Description:

The core standard on terminology work, ISO 704 *Terminology work — Principles and methods*, is being used by a growing number of diverse user groups. In order to better meet the varied needs of these groups, the ISO/TC 37 on *Terminology and other language resources* has set up a task force to make proposals concerning a new revision of ISO 704. The task force comprises a core group from TC 37 together with a small group of selected representatives from various communities of practice. This workshop is intended to provide a forum for discussing multidisciplinary input to ISO TC 37 concerning a future revision of ISO 704.

The workshop is intended to provide a forum for discussing input to the ISO TC 37 meetings, which will take place immediately after the conference, and will be a unique opportunity for experts from outside TC 37 to contribute to the discussions

- Presentation of needs from selected user group representatives
- Discussion of how to meet needs, with consideration of strategies to accommodate potentially conflicting needs
- Discussion of a new proposal for a general example to be used in the standard
