### 1. Programme-specific rules and requirements

#### Year 1

Students are not permitted to change language after Semester One of Year One.

#### Years 1 and 2

## **Compulsory attendance**

All core language modules in Years 1 and 2 require that students attend at least 80% of language classes. Where a student fails to do so, and in the absence of documentation to support exceptional circumstances, s/he will be required to present for a meeting with the Programme Chair, SALIS Teaching Convenor and/ or Module Coordinator in advance of attempting examinations/assessments and/or submitting coursework.

#### Year 3

#### **Language Pathways and Year 3**

Students opting for the single language pathway spend Year 3 in the country of their chosen language.

Students of Japanese or Chinese who opt for the dual language pathway are required to spend Year 3 in, respectively, Japan or China.

### Year 4

- 1) Year 4 students are <u>not</u> permitted to pursue a <u>single language pathway in a language other than</u> the one of the country in which they completed Year 3 (i.e. a student who spends Year 3 in Spain <u>cannot</u> take a single language pathway in German in Year 4).
- 2) In order to pursue a <u>dual language pathway</u> in Year 4, students are required to take credits or recognised courses in <u>both</u> languages while studying abroad. Students who are opting for a single language pathway will be encouraged to attend the small number of partner universities that do not offer the second language.
- 3) Year 4 students studying Irish are not permitted to pursue a single language pathway.



#### 2. Derogations from Marks & Standards

## 3. Progression

Students must successfully have completed a minimum of 60 credits in a study period in order to progress to the next study period. Students will not be permitted to 'carry' modules. [Ref.: DCU M&S, Item 7.2.1].

## ALIS Year 3 Regulation for entry to Year 4

Students are required to resit failed elements of Year 3 coursework at the partner university. Where the partner university does not allow for this and where students have accumulated a minimum of 50 of the required 60 DCU-equivalent credits required in Year 3 (i.e. 80% of assigned workload), the Year Abroad Coordinator, in conjunction with relevant colleagues, will set resit examinations/assignments in DCU. The deadline for the completion of such examinations/assignments will be determined by the date of the Year 3 final PAB.

When resits of Semester 1 modules preclude students from participating in Semester 2 modules, students are still required to pass Semester 1 modules and to accumulate Semester 2 credits by completing modules and/or approved courses as agreed in consultation with Coordinator and Chairperson.

Year Abroad students who do not pass the year must complete repeat components at a partner university. SALIS does not offer Year Abroad Repeat components

### Returning before completion of Year Abroad / Non-departure:

The Year Abroad is a compulsory component of ALTS. If a students does not wish to go abroad or is not in a position to do so, s/he should (1) apply to transfer onto another programme that does not involve a Year Abroad OR (2) seek a Deferral or Leave of Absence until s/he is in a position to go abroad.

SALIS does not offer a replacement Year Abroad (in Ireland).

### 4. Compensation

Compensation may apply, within the regulations specified in Marks and Standards, to all modules except the following [Ref: DCU M&S Item 7.2.5]:
