6.1 Programme Regulations

The Secretary indicated that having reviewed all Programme Regulations over the summer period she had noted a divergence in the style and content of the submitted regulations. It was suggested that a review of Programme Regulations would take place, given that the process had been in place for a number of years. It was agreed that a meeting would be convened with the Associate Deans for Teaching and Learning and Secretaries of Faculty Teaching and Learning Committees to discuss and agree a common regulation template and its implementation.

In addition, it was suggested that the timeframe for the consideration and approval of Programme Regulations by USC would be adjusted to take account of Faculty schedules around the update of Academic Structures and consideration of Programme Regulations. It was <u>agreed</u> that the final approval of Programme Regulations would take place at the May 2015 USC meeting.

It was noted that the revised examination regulations under consideration represented an amalgamation of the regulations of the incorporating colleges. The amendments to the regulations were <u>approved</u>, subject to clarification on the use of the word 'clothing' under regulation 5.5.
