

## McAleese Scholarships for Northern Ireland Students **APPLICATION FORM**

- In 2014-2015 there will be up to forty scholarships available to DCU applicants with a permanent home address in Northern Ireland, presenting 3 A Level results. These scholarships will include an award of €1000, allowing successful applicants to gain one of forty reserved places across a number of DCU undergraduate programmes.
- Restrictions: There are a number of programmes which will not be included in this scholarship process due to externally driven restrictions to programme quotas.
- Entry Requirements: Applicants must meet DCU minimum entry requirements and specific programme entry requirements as outlined on the DCU website, http://www4.dcu.ie/registry/entry.shtml. The scholarships are based on presentation of three A-levels, with a minimum requirement of 2 'A' and 1 'B' grades. The required personal statement below will be used in the event of ties on point scoring.
- Eligibility: To be eligible, applicants must apply through the Central Applications Office before the normal closing date for applications, 1<sup>st</sup> February 5.15pm, or before the late closing date for applications, 1<sup>st</sup> May 5.15pm. See: www.cao.ie for further information. In addition, students must submit this form with a personal statement, directly to DCU by 5pm on 30<sup>th</sup> May 2014. Applications received after this date will not be processed. The form must be completed in block capital letters using **BLACK** ink. All questions **MUST** be answered.
