	The REC Terms of Reference (ToR) have been revised and shared with the committee. Some faculties have deferred nomination of REC members until the ToR have been signed off. REC Chair is hopeful that the ToR will be approved by the RC at		



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	their next meeting. Discussions around devolvement of research ethics review to faculties were raised during the RC meeting. The REC Chair and Secretary have had initial conversations with the DCU insurance manager and there do not seem to be any implications from an insurance perspective regarding devolvement. However, the REC Chair will be advising the RC of the importance of ensuring that accountability of local faculty review processes is robust. Compliments were again paid to REC for the continued facilitation of REC review during COVID-19.		
2.c.	The REC Chair brought to the attention of the committee a recent example where a researcher wanted to include 16-18 year-olds in a research project, without obtaining parental consent. After seeking legal advice, it was confirmed that 16-18 year-olds could provide consent themselves, if no personal or sensitive data was being collected and where the anticipated risk to participants was very low. Other possible scenarios where parental consent for 16-18 year-olds could be problematic would be in situations where it breaches the child's confidentiality or puts the child at risk/harm. Moving forward, similar applications would be dealt with on a case-by-case basis. The DCU Child Protection guidelines will be updated by the Office of the Chief Operations Officer to reflect this possibility and facilitate this change. Ultimately, however, the REC will be guided by the legal advice, in this regard, for each individual project.	N/A	N/A
