SECTION A: MINUTES AND RELATED ISSUES

The Chair opened the meeting and welcomed Ms Isabelle Caulfield (Registry), Ms Christina O'Keeffe (Research Student Representative) and Dr Maura Coulter (ADR, Institute of Education) to the meeting as new members of GRSB.

1. Adoption of the agenda

The agenda was adopted subject to the inclusion of a late item, 13.2.

2. Minutes of the meeting of 5 December 2019

The minutes of the meeting of 5 December 2019 were approved and signed by the Chair.

3. Matters arising from the minutes of 5 December 2019

- 3.1 It was <u>noted</u> that work on guidelines on recital/performance and related capacity building is ongoing (item 3.3).
- 3.2 It was <u>noted</u> that follow-up with respect to a PGR4 form for a student in the School of Health and Human Performance, which was approved subject to a new internal examiner being nominated, is ongoing (item 3.4) (original ref. item 9.28, 18 April 2019).

The Chair advised the Board that revised wording, incorporating the proposed changes, will be brought to the next meeting of GRSB for consideration.

8. PGR3 form update

The Chair presented proposed guidance text to be included on PGR3 forms. It was <u>noted</u> that the majority of PGR3 forms returned to Schools by GRSB are due to insufficient detail being included in section B(i) and B(ii) of the form. The Chair invited feedback from the Faculties on the new text. A revised PGR3 will be brought to the next meeting of GRSB for consideration.

9. Research Appeal

The Secretary gave a brief update on changes to the research appeal form which now includes a data protection notice and some further clarity on the provision of documented evidence. The Secretary proposed that future appeal documentation be circulated electronically using Google Drive. This will be reviewed after the next appeal process.
