#### 5. COVID-19: Continuity Arrangements

The Chair updated GRSB on ongoing contingency planning in respect of PGR students and other researchers in the University. The Board were informed that an email was sent to all PGR students during the week clarifying some key points regarding PRG paperwork, logistical arrangements and wellbeing. A short survey has also been issued by GSO and findings of this survey will inform planned 'virtual coffee sessions' which will be hosted by the Dean of Graduate Studies.

There was a brief discussion on DoctoralNet and the supplemental supports available to students through this subscription. The Chair informed the Board that Alana James (DoctoralNet) has agreed to speak at one of the planned sessions.

The uncertainty facing PGR students was discussed including fees issues and access to research facilities. It was agreed that a decision on the Card Fee for final year students should be prioritised.

M. Coulter raised two issues in relation to PGR students in the IOE.

- Data collection issues are causing concerns for students, particularly for those who cannot collect data remotely and those who are conducting research involving children. These issues were <u>noted</u> by the Board. The Chair advised the Board that issues around data collection for PGRs is currently under review.
- Issues around completing the PGR13 was raised, particularly in relation to incoming international students for 20/21 and those who are currently aboard who may not be able to return for some time. It was <u>agreed</u> that it will be important to collect this information but a revised/streamlined process may be required.
