SECTION A: MINUTES AND RELATED ISSUES

1. Adoption of the agenda

The agenda was adopted.

2. Minutes of the meeting of 25 February 2021

The minutes of the meeting of 25 February 2021 were <u>approved</u>. It was noted that formal minutes would be signed once on-campus activity resumes.

3. Matters arising from the minutes of 10 December 2020

- 3.1 It was <u>noted</u> that work on guidelines on recital performance and related capacity building is ongoing (item 3.1).
- 3.2 It was <u>noted</u> that follow up with respect to a PGR14 for a student in the School of Nursing, Psychotherapy and Community Health, which was approved subject to the form being completed by the supervisor, is ongoing (item 3.2) (original ref. 9.27, 31 August 2020).
- 3.3 It was <u>noted</u> that follow up with respect to a PGR4 for a student in the School of English, for which a decision was deferred pending clarification that the full supervisory panel is in support of the early submission, is complete (item 9.15).
- 3.4 It was <u>noted</u> that the revised guidance on research student annual leave entitlements is on the agenda (item 6) of today's meeting (item 7).

SECTION B: Policy and strategy issues

4. Graduate researcher development

There were no items for consideration.

5. COVID-19: Continuity arrangements

The Chair updated the GRSB on the second HEA cost extension scheme for PGR students. 40 applications were received for the call and payments will be processed shortly. It is expected that further calls will follow. The Chair informed the GRSB that feedback has been sent to the HEA regarding the exclusion of part-time research students from the scheme.

The Chair advised the GRSB that he is continuing to meet with the ADRs to consider the longer-term implications of the pandemic for research students.

6. Research student annual leave entitlement

The revised guidance for annual leave entitlement was <u>approved</u>. It was <u>noted</u> that this guidance would be published on the GSO website and included in the next *Graduate Research Guide*.

It was <u>noted</u> that there are currently no arrangements for sick pay and that national guidance around this would be useful.

7. Updates to Academic Regulations for Postgraduate Degrees by Research and Thesis 2021-2022

The updates to the *Academic Regulations for Postgraduate Degrees by Research and Thesis 2021-2022* were considered by the GRSB. The Chair thanked Registry colleagues for their work on this. The following revisions were considered:

- 1.1.3: inclusion of the award of DProfElite Doctor of Elite Performance (Sport);
- 4.1: references to PAC replaced with 'student application portal';
- 8.3: modified text to provide clarity on the role of GRSB in approving/noting members of the examination panel (updates also reflected in 10.3.2 and 10.3.4);
- 8.5.2, 8.6.1 and 8.6.3: text updated to clarify that unsuccessful candidates will be formally notified of the outcome following the relevant FABRD meeting so that they may engage in the appeals process where relevant;
- 9.1.5: updated to include the maximum word limit for a professional doctorate thesis;
- 9.3.2: updated to confirm when the period for restricted access of a thesis commences;

- 9.4.4: addition of the Irish translation of the thesis declaration;
- 11.4.4 and 11.5.1: updated to clarify responsibility for communicating the details of corrections following a *viva voce* examination;
- 11.5.1: updated to provide clarity on the submission of the examination form (PGR6) to Registry;
- 13.3.3. updated based on GRSBs review of the appeals documentation in January 2021 to clarify the type of documentation that is deemed acceptable for purposes of an appeal.
