The workload and resources that are required to implement devolvement have been communicated by the REC Chair to the RC. There is still ongoing discussion as to how risk of applications will be assessed by faculties. From a REC perspective, risk is dictated by the context of the research and is therefore assessed on a case-by-case basis. The REC Chair has recommended that the RC organise a meeting between REC, DPU, ISS, TEU, COO, legal representatives, etc. to decide on the level of risk that should be reviewed at a faculty level. It has also been recommended by the REC Chair, to the RC, that the Chair of each Faculty Research Ethics Panel (FREP) attends REC meetings to provide a report on research reviewed at a local level.
