#### 1. **Programme Specific Rules and Requirements**

1.1 Calculation for the Award Classification

The calculation of the final year award classification includes contributions from previous year's results, as follows: From 2016/17, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4th year precision marks will be included in the award classification calculation at the following weightings:

Year/Subject Contribution	Contribution to the award classification
Year 3	20%
Year 4	80%

#### 1.2 Monitored Attendance
