The use of photographs, video footage, music etc. is encouraged and welcome.

Paired reading, skills transfer – sewing/cookery/, log on and learn, mentoring/sharing and other innovative projects are examples of the types of initiatives we are looking for as long as they engage and benefit younger and older people.

DCU also invites submissions for Category 2 individual awards for innovation (see below).

This year there will be an additional category for individuals demonstrating enterprise and innovative projects which assist or enhancing the lives of older people – this can be an innovative product or service.

There will be three Awards in Category 1

Gold, Silver and Bronze which will be presented in DCU on May 8th.

Every participant group receiving an award will receive a Certificate of Participation for all involved.

There will be 3 Awards in Category 2

Gold, Silver and Bronze which will be presented in DCU on May 8th.

Every individual receiving an award will receive a Certificate of Participation.
