During hergraduate studies, she was a Co-op Fellow at the National Instituteof Standards and Technology (NIST) in Gaithersburg, Maryland.After a Postdoctoral Fellowship at the University of Missouri-Rolla,she joined the faculty at the University of Hawaii-Manoa in 1990.In 1996, she moved to the University of Cincinnati and waspromoted to Full Professor in 2001. She served as a member of theGreater Cincinnati Water Works (GCWW) Water Quality AdvisoryBoard for 16 years. The GCWW, one of the leading municipallyowned and operated utilities in the US, provides morethan 48 billion gallons of water a year to its customer base. Shemoved to Dublin City University in 2012 to become Director of theIrish Separation Science Cluster and Professor of ChemicalSciences.ExpertiseApryll's research interests include chromatography andelectrophoresis, separation mechanisms, chiral separations,exploring new separation methods, surface confined ionic liquidsas stationary phases, characterization of complex carbohydratesand nuclear forensics.
