A regular speaker both in Ireland and internationally, she has presented on Connected Health Business Models at the European Parliament.</p> <p>Her research work is highly regarded and has been recognised with a number of international awards and distinctions including the <i>Villanova University Research Excellence Award of Merit</i> and <i>Government Information Quarterly's Inaugural Best Research Paper Award</i>. She serves as Editor-in-Chief of the <i>Journal of Internet Commerce</i>. She is Associate Editor of the <i>European Journal of Information Systems</i>, Senior Editor of <i>Information Systems Management</i> and is Associate Editor of the <i>International Journal of Advanced Decision Sciences</i>. She also acts as an expert evaluator for the European Commission.</p> <p>She has significant expertise in healthcare technology impact assessment as well as eHealth business model development and is a Lead Principal Investigator in several international Ambient Healthcare Technology research projects that have recently been awarded over 8.43 million euros in funding from the European Commission.</p> <p>In 2008, she was appointed by the Minister for Health and Children, Mary Harney, T.D., to the Medical Council of Ireland. In 2012, she was appointed as a Non-Executive Director to the Board of Governors of the National Orthopaedic Hospital of Ireland, Clontarf.</p>
