His academic work is highly interdisciplinary and touches on issues relating to race, culture, politics, ethics, social justice, social work and education policy and practice. Dr Singh has an extensive media profile and has for over a decade hosted TV programmes on the Sikh and Akaal Channels covering a range of social, religious and political issues.
