Storyteller 2	David set out early the next morning and took the food to his brothers. He was just in time to hear Goliath challenging the Israelites as he did every morning.
Goliath	What are you doing over there? Choose one of your men to fight me. If he wins, we will be your slaves. If I win, you will be our slaves. I dare you
David	I'll fight him. I am used to fighting off lions or bears when they attack my lambs. God will be with me.
Storyteller 1	David went off to be fitted with armour but nothing was small enough. He took it all off, picked up his shepherd's stick and got his slingshot and five smooth stones from the stream.
