1	Good morning rhyme (Stepping Out p. 223)
2	Last week in R.E. we talked about Pentecost
3	Before that it was a Jewish Harvest festival when everyone went to celebrate in Jerusalem.
4	Imagine the scene. Jesus had died and had risen again but had gone back to God in heaven. His friends were left behind. They were scared and no one felt brave enough to keep going as they had before. Peter and John and the others were in room in the city.
5	Read Stepping Out p. 224 from top of page 'Then suddenlyto timid to go (2 paragraphs)
6	We made kites because they need wind to fly and they remind us of the wind from the story
7	When Peter and the others were on the street everyone stopped to listen to them. Peter told them about Jesus.
8	Read Stepping Out p. 224 . (Jesus of Nazareth - end of story)
9	People from all over the world began to hear the good news of Jesus. They brought that story back to their own countries and the message spread in lots of different languages
10	And keeps on spreading today.
11	In lots of different languages (you might like to translate Jesus loves me into different languages)
12	Even in a new language we learned this week
