

# Assembly (5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Class)

## Based on Term 1 Lesson 9

### Prayer

**Songs:** Seek ye first, What a friend we have in Jesus, O Lord hear my prayer, Father I place into your hands, Our Father.

**You need:** Large letters S T O P and a STOP sign

Pupil 1	Last week in RE we talked about prayer
Pupil 2	There are lots of different prayers and we pray some in assembly each week.
Pupil 1	The Lord's prayer is the most famous prayer because it was taught by Jesus
Pupil 2	Today in assembly we are going to tell you about 4 different types of prayers
Pupil 3	S is for Sorry
Pupil 4	Another word for sorry is Confess
Pupil 3	People confess or say sorry for what they have done wrong and they know if they are really sorry that God forgives them
All	Pupil washes white clothes Other pupils read Psalm 51 (p. 47)
Pupil 5	Now we have said sorry we are going to say thank you
Pupil 6	T is for Thank you
Pupil 5	We thought about all the things we wanted to say thank you to God for and we made them into a poem/ poster/ drama
All	Pupil reads poem/ displays poster of thank you prayers
Pupil 6	It is so much easier to say thank you than to say sorry.
Pupil 7	O is for Others.
Pupil 8	We thought about places and people that need our prayers
All	Pupils list/ share pictures or newspaper cuttings of others needing prayer
Pupil 9	P is for Please
Pupil 10	We all have things we want to pray about that we need ourselves.
Pupil 9	We talked about the times when please prayers don't seem to be answered in the way we wanted

Pupil 10	That doesn't mean we stop praying. We had some quiet times in our classroom when people say please prayers silently.
Pupil 11	STOP sign - Sorry, Thanks, Others, Please. Four different types of prayers. But together they say STOP
Pupil 12	It is important to remember to Stop and pray.
Prayers	Some pupil prayers The Lord's Prayer
