5	Then we heard the story of a saint called Francis - Saint Francis.
Teacher	(Dramatise the story)
or	This is Saint Francis. He lived in Italy over 800 years ago.
pupils	He was very very rich. He had a great life having fun with his
	friends and enjoying himself.
	But when he was 20 he was taken prisoner in a battle in his town.
	He spent a year in prison and while he was there he thought a lot.
	He decided to spend the rest of his life helping the poor.
	Francis got out of prison and went to Rome. He had on his nice
	smart clothes again.
	The first thing he did was swap his clothes with a poor man who was
	begging on the street. He spent the rest of that day with the poor
	homeless people on the street.
	For the rest of his life he dressed in a simple cloak with a rope tied
	around it.
	He gave away his money and taught people that following God was
	the most important thing.
6	Other people followed his example. They became known as
	Franciscans.
7	St Francis day is 4 October
8	St Francis is the patron saint of Italy (hold up flag)
9	And the patron saint of animals (pictures/ soft toys)

10	And he made the first Christmas crib
11	St Francis told people all about God and he talked a lot about peace
12	The song Make me a channel of your peace is from a prayer he wrote
13	Children's prayers on theme of peace or animals or people who have been good examples to us.
