Visuals based on the Malawi or other water project

Pupil 1	Last week in R.E. we talked about water.
Pupil 2	We made a list of all the things we need water for
Pupils	Read items from the list/ visual aids / props
Pupil 1	Did you know that over 1 billion people in the world do not have a safe water supply?
Pupil 2	And 4 children die every minute from diseases caused by not having safe clean water.
Pupil 1	And 15% people in the world have no tap
Pupil 3	We looked in the Bible at stories about water
Pupil 4	Here is one of the stories (choose from the first 4 readings on p. 30) or read Exodus 17:1-6
Pupil 5	The people in the story really needed water to survive
Pupil 6	We worked out how much water we used in one week
Pupil 5	And thought about how we could save water
Pupil 6	We came up with some strategies
Pupils	Read out some ideas
Pupil 7	Then we heard about the work of Christian Aid.
Pupil 8	Christian Aid was founded in the middle of the 20 <sup>th</sup> century to help refugees after World War 2.
Pupil 9	Now it works in fifty of the poorest countries of the world in partnership with local organisations to help people improve their lives.
Pupil 8	One of the ways they do this is by helping villages and towns get a safe water supply.
Pupil 9	They know that a safe water supply is the answer to saving many lives.
Pupil 8	Christian Aid has a motto ' We believe in life before death'
Pupil 10	Malawi is in Africa

Pupil 11	We found out some facts about Malawi
Pupils	Share some facts
Pupil 10	We learned some Tumbuka
Pupils	Share some words/ phrases
Pupil 11	We learned about a water project in Malawi
Pupil 12	Tell the stopre of Sichinga's family
