We have made it to the final 50 ideas and are hoping to advance and go on to win it, with the goal of starting our own business as a result.



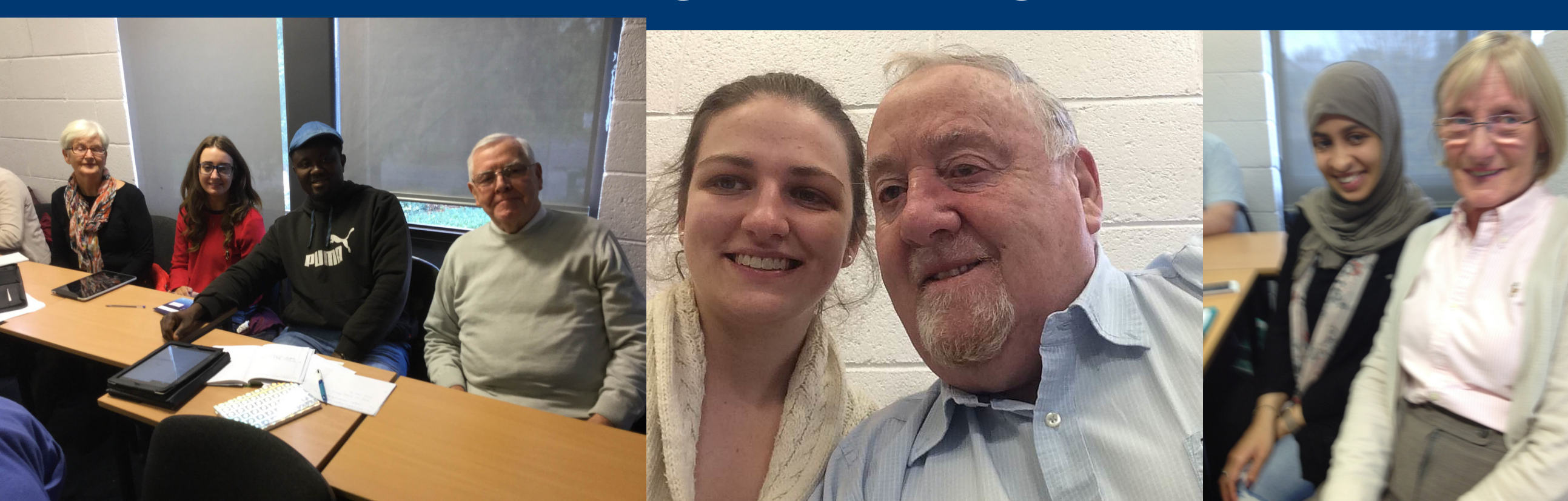
## 100 Minds Project
