5. COVID-19 – continuity arrangements

5.1 The Chair informed members of a recent communication received from the HEA, informing institutions of plans to close the HEA Covid-19 fund. The communication received indicates that

institutions will have until 14 July 2021 to allocate any remaining funds, prioritising research students who have projects ending in 2021.

It was <u>noted</u> that this is a significant decision by the HEA. It was <u>noted</u> that this decision will have implications for other students who have been impacted by Covid-19, but who have not had an opportunity to avail of additional funding to date.

It was <u>noted</u> that this issue will be discussed further at the next meeting of the IUA VP/Deans of Research Group.

5.2 The Chair <u>noted</u> DCU plans for a phased and incremental return to campus over the summer months. Arrangements for the return of research students will need to be managed locally, taking into account capacities and priority activities.

It was <u>noted</u> that existing arrangements for research students engaging with Registry will remain as per current guidelines until the end of September 2021.

It was <u>noted</u> that guidance on viva voce examinations will be revisiting in the coming weeks. It was <u>noted</u> that online examinations have afforded Schools the possibility of recruiting from a wider pool of external examiners and that this should be taken into consideration when reviewing the examination process.

6. Non-attendance at Research Integrity Training

It was <u>noted</u> that all first year research students are required to complete the online research integrity module on Loop. In previous years, non-completion of the module was communicated by the Graduates Studies Office to Heads of School. It is proposed that such notifications be communicated to the Principal Supervisors going forward. This change to the process was <u>noted</u>.
