SECTION A: MINUTES AND RELATED ISSUES

1. Adoption of the agenda

The agenda was adopted.

2. Minutes of the meeting of 17 June 2021

The minutes of the meeting of 17 June 2021 were approved.

3. Matters arising from the minutes

- 3.1 It was <u>noted</u> that follow up with respect to a PGR3 form for a student in the School of Electronic Engineering, which was not approved due to the nominated internal examiner being the independent panel member, is ongoing (item 7.9).
- 3.2 It was <u>noted</u> that follow up with respect to a PGR4 form for a student in the School of Creative Arts, DkIT, which was approved subject to receipt of the student's signature, is now complete (item 8.15).

- 3.4 It was <u>noted</u> that follow up with respect to a PGR4 form for a student in the School of Nursing, Psychotherapy and Community Health, for which a decision was deferred pending confirmation that the external examiner meets the requirements, is now complete (item 3.1) (original ref. 9.40, 8 April 2021).
- 3.5 It was <u>noted</u> that follow up with respect to a PGR3 form for a student in the School of Mechanical and Manufacturing Engineering, where it was requested that any previous PGR3 forms be submitted for approval, is now complete (item 7.12).
- 3.6 It was <u>noted</u> that follow up with respect to a PGR4 form for a student in the School of Nursing, Psychotherapy and Community Health, which was not approved as the external examiner does not meet the requirements, is now complete (item 8.7).
- 3.7 It was <u>noted</u> that follow up with respect to a PGR4 form for a student in the School of STEM Education, Innovation and Global Studies, which was not approved as the external examiner does not meet the requirements, is now complete (item 8.10).

SECTION B: POLICY AND STRATEGY ISSUES

4. Graduate researcher development

There were no items for discussion.

5. COVID-19 – continuity arrangements

- 5.1 The Chair informed members that it is expected that research students would be encouraged to return to campus in September, and many may already have returned as part of the phased return over the summer.
- 5.2 It was <u>noted</u> that *Viva Voce* examinations are continuing online for the most part, with a small number of hybrid arrangements being facilitated over the summer. The Chair informed members that he expects that the hybrid model will become more prevalent over the coming weeks. It was <u>noted</u> that a Head of School can sign off on a *Viva Voce* where the External Examiner is joining remotely but that approval from the Dean of Graduate Studies is required where a student is attending remotely.
- 5.3 It was <u>noted</u> that the process for the submission of paperwork and theses to Registry will be reviewed before the end of September.

6. GRSB Standing Committee to Consider Research Appeals

6.1 GRSB Standing Committee Membership, 2021-22

The membership was noted.

6.2 Standard operating procedures for management of appeals by research students

The Chair drew attention to a proposed revision to the standard operating procedures, to allow for the student representative to be replaced with an alternative, should there be a perceived conflict of interest. It was <u>agreed</u> that the change was appropriate and the revised SOP was <u>noted</u>. It was <u>noted</u> that this text has also been included in the membership document for consideration at the next meeting of Academic Council.

7. Proposed amendment to the PGR6 form for 2021-22

A proposal to amend the PGR6 form to reflect regulation 11.4.5 was put forward by Registry. Members discussed the implications of highlighting a timeframe for corrections. It was <u>agreed</u> that any timeframe should be indicative and should not suggest a hard deadline to students. It was <u>agreed</u> that setting out an indicative timeframe is useful for students in providing some guidance on how much work is required. It was <u>agreed</u> that section D1 of the form be updated to include the following text after the first bullet point: '…including an indicative timeframe for these changes'.

- 12.1 The Chair briefed members on matters related to the 'Tell it Straight' competition.
- 12.2 Professor S. O'Brien informed members that a query was raised at Faculty level regarding regulation 9.4.3. It was <u>noted</u> that the regulation does not permit the use of external professionals or organisations for proof-reading or copy-editing. It was <u>noted</u> that National Academic Integrity Network (NAIN) will be launching new guidance and a lexicon next week. It was <u>noted</u> that proof-reading and copy-editing services may become part of a wider conversion regarding research integrity. It was agreed that this regulation would be kept under review as work in this space progresses.
