Assessment Details

All students wishing to participate in CTYI courses must first take an assessment to establish their eligibility. No preparation or revision is required. No materials are needed other than a pencil and an eraser. Assessment locations, dates and times can be found overleaf. Sample questions may be accessed on our website https://www.dcu.ie/ctyi/ys-assessment.shtml#Assessment_YS

Assessment for 8-12 year olds

Students in this age group sit three tests: Abstract Reasoning (30 mins), Verbal Reasoning (20 mins) and Numerical Reasoning (30 mins). The assessment includes a short and takes 1.5 hours.

Assessment for 6-7 year olds

Students in this age group sit two tests: Abstract Reasoning (30 mins) and Verbal Reasoning (20 mins). Children must be able to read to take part. This assessment takes 1 hour to complete.

Evaluation of Psychological Report

Students who have been assessed independently by an educational psychologist may submit a report between the 1st of September and the 31st May for consideration. Please complete this form and return with the evaluation fee is €50.

To Apply for an Assessment

Complete the application form and return no later than 10 working days before your preferred assessment date. Applications received after this time will be assigned the next available date. Please note assessment dates cannot be changed.

Assessment Fee

The €50 assessment fee is made payable to "CTYI" by cheque, postal order or bank draft. Fees are non-refundable and not transferable.

Courses

CTYI courses are academically challenging and allow students to meet and mix with like-minded peers. A wide range of courses, not ordinarily available in primary school, are available. CTYI have Centres offering Saturday and summer programmes in Dublin (DCU), Cork (UCC), Limerick (MIC), Athlone (AIT), Galway (NUIG), Letterkenny (LYIT), Sligo (SIT), Tralee (ITT) and Wexford (CIT). Courses for 6-7 year olds are available in Dublin and Cork only. All eligible students will be notified of exact dates and locations before the start of each term. Correspondence courses are also available to all children who qualify in assessment. Courses are conducted by means of email and can be done at home or in school. Students must have the help of a parent/guardian/teacher to facilitate their participation.
