MSc in Education & Training Management (Leadership)

The M.Sc. in Education and Training Management (Leadership) is suitable for those working as, or aspiring to be, leaders in education and training contexts. In the current context the strategic leadership of education and training will be vital to the economic and social goals that have been established for Ireland. On this two year, part time programme, you learn through engagement in face-to-face sessions and lectures as well as through engagement in DCU's virtual learning environment. Case studies, online engagement, projects and assignments are combined with expert presentations and discussion to explore the role of the manager and leader in the 21st century. Current participants on the programme are drawn from the widely varying fields of education (primary, post-primary, third level, adult education), corporate training, industry, nursing, government departments and other state agencies.

MSc in Education & Training Management (e-Learning)

The M.Sc. in Education and Training Management (e-Learning) programme is a two-year part-time programme. It is offered through a blended approach where you will benefit from synchronous web conferencing, engagement in online environments and face-to-face settings. A defining aspect of the programme is learning together. You are encouraged to collaboratively reflect on and share your learning through a range of activities and social networking. The programme structure, support and research design enables you to enhance your own personal and professional development. You can choose to design and develop an artefact as part of the dissertation research. The lecturers and guest speakers bring a diverse range of expertise to the programme. These contributions allow for a variety of perspectives and new approaches to learning and eLearning. Programme participants come from a range of backgrounds and so contribute to a breadth of experience and a dynamic learning environment.
