

# DCU Glasnevin Campus

## Information Points

There will be four Open Day Information Points on the DCU Glasnevin Campus. You will find them at the following locations: **Collins Avenue Entrance - The U Building (Student Centre) - The Helix - The Interfaith Centre.** On the day, make sure to look out for our Student Ambassadors wearing 'Can I Help' red high vis jackets; they will be able to assist you with any queries.

## Course Presentations

DCU offers 70 plus undergraduate degree courses in the areas of Sustainability, Business, Languages, Arts, Humanities, Science, Health, Engineering, Computing, Education and Teaching. The presentations will cover course content, choices within degrees, difference between similar degree courses, work placements and career prospects. Each presentation will be 20-30 minutes in duration and will be repeated throughout the day. So, for example, if you are interested in attending the Aviation Management talk, go to room Q122 in the Business School (Q) at 10.30, 11.30, 12.30 or 13.30 (Friday talk times).

## Demonstrations and Tours

Selected Schools within the **Faculty of Science and Health** will provide tours and/or demonstrations in the labs, skills centres. The starting point of these tours will be from the stands located in the atrium of the Lonsdale (X) Building and in the Nursing (H) Building. Our VR lab will be open for demonstrations this Open Day but you will need to **book your slot** to take part, at the reception desk on the ground floor of the Business School, as spaces are limited.

"The **Colm Delves VR Lab** allows us to develop customised experiences for DCU students, such as bringing you to places in the developing world so they can become more globally aware leaders by understanding challenges associated with business development in unfamiliar countries, or allowing you to practice ethical decision-making and experience outcomes based on the decisions they choose to make."

**Media facilities** including the TV and Radio studios in the School of Communications and the language and translation laboratories in the **School of Applied Language and Intercultural Studies** will be open to visit to those who are interested in these areas.

The **Faculty of Engineering and Computing** will also be conducting a wide range of demonstrations in the Stokes (S) Building.




