
Since assuming responsibility for GP Training from the HSE in December 2020, the College provides specialist training in general practice in Ireland and provide a national training programme (four years in duration). Previously this was devolved to 14 schemes nationwide.

Training Programme, to be delivered across all existing GP Training schemes in Ireland.



The digital technologies included the **Moodle VLE**(3.9) as the virtual hub for centralised learning activities and resources to host learning resources and support online discussions; interactive **Articulate** online learning resources; live and recorded online master classes; and other digital resources including ebooks in **Book**Creator



Moode SCHEME SITES






- How can we support our directing teams and scheme administrators with administrative tasks in with rapidly increasing trainee numbers?
 - Scalable solutions
- How can we standardise administrative processes across each of the 13 different schemes?
- How can we update and upgrade administrative processes into the 21st century?

GAME PLAN

- Provide each scheme team with teacher access to their own Moodle course
- Use Moodle courses as smart websites to create a central hub for each scheme
 - Stopped using the term "Course" Now: "Scheme Site"
- Provide templates for these sites that allow for flexibility and adaptation at scheme level
- Train scheme directing teams to use Moodle
- Enroll trainees and start using Moodle!
 - Let schemes determine when ready to go live


IMPLEMENTATION

- Category: GP Training
- Sub Category: 1 per scheme
- Drop a "Scheme Site" Course
 Template into each category, grant
 permissions at this level
- Enrollment using cohort sync with webgroups from our cetral student database - all controlled centrally
- All scheme sites use Tiles course format - highly recommend!



Jaining SCHEME TEAMS


- About 80 individuals across the 13 schemes
- Initially, 1 training session per scheme (sessions recorded) Summer 2022
 - Moodle ABCs: What is Moodle?, Log-in, "Turn editing on"
 - Edit/customize look & feel, sections (tiles) etc.
 - Add/edit basic activities and resources, document repositories (folders)
 - Using groups and group restrictions
- Further trainings depending on interest:
 - Assignments for document collection and Trainee logbooks
 - Attendance for day release
 - Quizzes, discussion boards, communications
 - Student folders for trainee document sharing
- Digital Support Hub for all Staff/Admin



Mork / PROGRESS

As of October, all 13 schemes were live with trainees accessing sites

- 6 or 7 schemes with significant regular use of Moodle Scheme Site
- 4 of 5 schemes who engage, but mostly only as a repository for documentation
- 1 or 2 schemes with little engagement





Our focus this year:


Inter-scheme collaboration

Giving schemes a platform to showcase what works (and what doesn't)

Encouraging scheme teams to contact each other directly

Consider giving scheme directing teams guest access to each others' sites

Sharing question banks between training schemes






Single sign-on is a blessing and a curse...our trainees don't have ICGP emails

HIGHLIGHTS

Most popular uses for Moodle Scheme Sites:

- Less emails....eventually!
 - Document repositories have meant reduces emails for schemes
 - Calendars, HR & Admin Documents, Certifications Documents, etc.
- Document collection and retention of submissions via assignments
- Announcements for communications
- Group restrictions
- Student folders for trainees to share documentation with each other
- Attendance
- Quizzes...pratice for ICGP Examination as well as checks for understanding
- Auto Certificates for blended learning resources
