Interactive Transfer Guide: Purpose



About ESRALE

The ESRALE network is coordinated by the <u>Technische</u>
<u>Universität Kaiserslautern – Distance and Independent Studies</u>
<u>Centre</u>. It comprises 12 partners in ten countries selected for the **complementary expertise** they bring to the work programme.

Key **outcomes** from the project include:

- ✓ The development of a new European Masters Programme in Adult Learning and Education (EMAE) designed to meet: (a) changing European circumstances, (b) changing professional requirements, and (c) new e-learning opportunities.
- ✓ A <u>Doctoral Programme</u> designed to promote research, research competence and scientific exchange in the field of Adult Learning and Education (ALE), with a labour market orientation to facilitate employability in expanding areas of adult learning across different sectors.
- ✓ The development of tools for <u>Validation of Prior Learning</u> (VPL) identifying and documenting the relevant competencies for access to the study program (European Masters) for practitioners in the field of ALE.
- ✓ The development of models for intensive <u>Summer Academies</u> in order to facilitate engagement and learning by EMAE and PhD students from different countries and different cultural backgrounds.
- ✓ Intellectual contributions to the field of ALE through academic publications arising from papers presented at ESRALE seminars and academies, as well as manuals (anthologies) on comparative research, empirical research and research with a European dimension. These publications are widely available and contributing to enhancing the knowledge base for the development of European ALE.
