Réamhrá

Institiúid dinimiciúil dlúth-thaighde is ea DCU (www.dcu.ie) a mbaineann gné ilréimseach dhomhanda léi agus aithnítear í as caighdeán agus tionchar a cuid céimithe, agus as a plé leis an léann chun leasa na sochaí agus an gheilleagair. Cuirtear oiliúint den scoth ar a cuid mac léinn trí oideachas ardchaigheáin iomlánaíoch atá in oiriúint do dhúshláin agus deiseanna an 21ú haois a chur ar fáil dóibh le go bhfeidhmeoidh siad go rathúil sa saol agus sa láthair oibre. Mar Ollscoil Fiontair na hÉireann, baineann an nuálaíocht agus an fhiontraíocht go smior léi mar aon le teist mhaith a bheith uirthi as caidreamh éifeachtúil a thógáil le hearnáil na fiontraíochta, fiontair thráchtála, shoisialta agus chultúrtha san áireamh. Toisc feabhas a cuid gníomhaíochtaí oideachais agus taighde, baineann sí áit amach go leanúnach i rangú domhanda na n-ollscoileanna óga is fearr (e.g. QS top 50 under 50; THE top 100 under 50).

Scoil dhlúth-thaighde is ea Fiontar & Scoil na Gaeilge ina bhfuil réimse clár acadúil ar fáil ag leibhéal BA, MA agus PhD, lena n-áirítear *BA Gnó agus Gaeilge*, *BA Gaeilge agus Iriseoireacht*, agus *MSc i nGnó agus i dTeicneolaíocht an Eolais*. Múineann baill foirne ar an gClár Comhonoracha BA laistigh de Dhámh na nDaonnachtaí agus na nEolaíochtaí Sóisialta, agus ar chlár an BEd agus ar an Máistreacht Ghairmiúil san Oideachas (Bunscolaíocht) in Institiúid Oideachais DCU. Dírítear go tréan sa Scoil ar an teagasc, an taighde agus na daonnachtaí digiteacha. Beifear ag súil go n-imreoidh an t-iarrthóir rathúil ról i seachadadh agus i bhforbairt chlár mhúinte na Scoile agus sa phleanáil a bhainfidh le cláir nua a aithint agus a fhorbairt de réir mar is cuí. Bíonn an-deis ag iarrthóirí bheith ag teagasc laistigh dá réimsí saineolais féin ar chlár na Scoile agus tá méadú ag teacht de réir a chéile ar líon na n-iarrthóirí PhD.

Scileanna agus Taithí

Is mian le DCU Ollamh Cúnta le Gaeilge (conradh ar théarma seasta 3 bliana) a cheapadh ón 1 Meán Fómhair 2019. Ba chóir go mbeadh céim onóracha sa Ghaeilge agus PhD i réimse cuí mar aon le próifíl taighde agus foilseachán den scoth ag iarratasóirí. Ní mór dóibh taithí chuí trí bliana ar a laghad de theagasc na Gaeilge in earnáil an ardoideachais a bheith acu agus bheith inniúil ar dhea-chaidreamh a chothú le rannpháirtithe acadúla agus neamhadúla.
