The school now wishes to appoint a Lecturer in Organic Medicinal Chemistry on a 9-month fixed term contract. We are seeking outstanding, enthusiastic candidates with teaching and research interests in any areas of organic synthesis and medicinal chemistry. The successful candidate will be expected to pursue his/her research interests by collaborating with existing research groups in the School. The post-holder will also have the opportunity to develop collaborations with staff in associated DCU research Centres and Institutes (<http://www.dcu.ie/research/institutes.shtml>).

The post holder will be expected to contribute to the overall teaching of the School, specifically to present lecture courses in medicinal and organic chemistry in the Chemical and Pharmaceutical Sciences programme. These courses are mainly at senior undergraduate level (3rd and 4th years of four year degree programmes). In addition s/he will supervise laboratory courses on the Chemical and Pharmaceutical Sciences programme.

Applicants for the post must hold a PhD and possess a research track record in organic/medicinal chemistry.
