



Teaching Fellow in the School of Health and Human Performance, DCU.

Applications are invited from suitable candidates for the post of teaching fellow on the B.Sc. in Physical Education with Biology, and on the B.Sc. in Physical Education with Maths. Candidates must have a first or second class honours degree in Physical Education, and preferably a postgraduate qualification in a cognate area. Candidates must demonstrate an excellent performance record in teaching (ideally both second and third level), with specialist interest and experience in applied areas (e.g. Aquatics, Dance, Adventure Activities and Gymnastics). Relevant additional professional qualifications are desirable, as is a capacity to lecture the Sociology of in PE and School Sport module (but not essential). The candidate should have high quality interpersonal and communication skills consistent with the highest quality of teaching and learning, together with evidence of successful teamwork and a collegial approach.

The primary role of the Teaching Fellow would be to contribute to:

- i. The delivery and management of courses at undergraduate level within the School.
- ii. The supervision of pre-service teachers during their school-based placement.
- iii. The development and design of courses at undergraduate level within the School

Other important roles would be to contribute to:

- iv. The co-ordination and supervision of final year research projects in the areas pedagogy, dance, gymnastics and aquatics.
- v. The administrative activity within the School.
- vi. The development of community links and representing the School of Health and Human Performance and DCU.
