



## **Ollscoil Chathair Bhaile Átha Cliath**

#### **Scoil na Teanga, na Litearthachta agus an Oideachas Luath-Óige**

#### **Ollamh Cúnta san Oideachas (Teagasc na Gaeilge)**

#### **Conradh 3 bliana**

##### **Réamhrá**

Is í Institiúid Oideachais Ollscoil Chathair Bhaile Átha Cliath an dámh is nua in Ollscoil Chathair Bhaile Átha Cliath. Tá sé suite ar shaoráid shaintógtha ar luach €70 milliún ar Champas Phádraig OCBÁC i nDroim Conrach i mBaile Átha Cliath. Bunaíodh é in 2016 mar an chéad Dámh Ollscoile um Oideachas in Éirinn, agus tá baill foirne ann de níos mó ná 140 acadóir agus freastalaíonn os cionn 4,000 mac léinn air.

San Institiúid, tugtar le chéile na mic léinn go léir ó gach réimse oideachais lena n-áirítear oideachas luath-óige, bunscoile agus iar-bhunscoile, breisoideachas agus ardoideachas. Chomh maith le raon de chláir fochéimithe san oideachas a sholáthar, cuireann an Institiúid raon leathan de chláir iarchéime múinte agus bunaithe ar thaighde ar fáil ar leibhéal dhochtúra, mháistreachta, dhiplóma agus theastais.

Mar ionad barr feabhais sna croí-réimsí Oiliúna Tosaigh Múinteoirí agus oideachas go ginearálta, tá réimse leathan d'ionaid taighde atá dírithe ar mhórspriocanna uailmhianacha mar chuid lárnach d'fhorbairt chláir taighde na hInstitiúide. Soláthraíonn an Institiúid timpeallacht oibre agus fhoghlama dhinimiciúil i gcomhlúadar saineolaithe atá aitheanta go hidirnáisiúnta sna réimsí: polasaí oideachais, oideachas ionchuimsithigh agus speisialta, curaclam agus oideolaíocht, meastóireacht, litearthacht, measúnú, oideachas múinteoireachta. Is féidir go mbeidh suíl ag baill foirne le deiseanna mar a bhaineann le hobairt ildisciplíneach ní amháin san Institiúid ach trasna na hOllscoile. Mar cheann de na príomhollscoileanna is óige ar domhan, eascraíodh bhunú an chúigiú dámh nua i gcomhthéacs an tuairim dhaingean go bhfuil staidéar agus taighde san oideachas mar aon leis an tacaíocht agus cúnaimh a chuirtear ar fáil do mhúinteoirí croilárnach i gclaoclú saoil agus pobail.

Tá Institiúid Oideachais DCU tiomanta do bharr feabhais oideachas agus nuálaíocht agus muiníneach go mbeidh ról rathúla agus ceannasaíochta ag mic léinn, foireann agus céimithe na hInstitiúide i gcomhthéacs na ndúshlán agus castachtaí a bhaineann le hoideachas an 21ú haois.

##### **Scoil na Teanga, na Litearthachta agus an Oideachas Luath-Óige**

Is í Scoil na Teanga, na Litearthachta agus an Oideachas Luath-óige ceann de na sé scoil atá mar chuid den Institiúid Oideachais. Cuireann an scoil go mór le réimse leathan de chláir oideachais ag leibhéal fochéime agus iarchéime. Tugtar le chéile dámh le saineolas den scoth lena n-áirítear teoiric, cleachtas, taighde agus polasaí sna réimsí teanga (Gaeilge & Béarla), litearthachta agus oideachas luath-óige. Tá foireann na scoile tiomanta do scoláireacht leanúnach agus d'fhiosrúchán mar a bhaineann le comhpháirtíocht chómhálartach le suíomhanna oideachas luath-óige, scoileanna, comhghleacaithe san Institiúid agus páirtithe leasmhara sa chóras oideachais.

##### **Ollamh Cúnta san Oideachas (Teagasc na Gaeilge)**

Tá sé i gceist ag Scoil na Teanga, na Litearthachta agus Oideachas Luath-Óige Ollamh Cúnta a cheapadh le dul ag obair mar chuid d'fhoireann Theagasc na Gaeilge. Beidh cúlra láidir ag an té a cheapfar i bhfoghlaim teanga, curaclam agus oideolaíocht mar a bhaineann le Teagasc na Gaeilge, mar aon le taithe ábhartha trí bliana acu ag an mbunleibhéal agus/nó iar-bhunleibhéal. Tá gá le cáilíocht iarchéime san Oideachas ina bhfuil dlúthnasc le Teagasc na Gaeilge agus bheadh sé inmhianaithe í seo a bheith ag leibhéal Dochtúireachta chomh maith le hardscileanna sa Ghaeilge. Beidh taithe in oideachas do mhúinteoirí an-inmhianaithe. Beidh sárscileanna idirphearsanta agus comhoibríoch ag an té a cheapfar chomh maith le hardscileanna riaracháin agus eagrúcháin, mar aon le léiriú cumais ICT (Teicneolaíocht Faisnéise agus Cumarsáide) a úsáid i múineadh Theagasc na Gaeilge. Beidh ceapadh an iarrthóra faoi réir Grinnfhiosrúchán an Gharda Síochána.

## Múineadh

Maidir leis an té a cheapfar, beifear ag súil go gcuirfidh sé/sí go suntasach le forbairt, múineadh, measúnú agus riarachán trasna réimse clár ag leibhéal fochéime agus iarchéime. Cuimseoidh an múineadh seo dearadh agus cur i láthair modúl, socrúchán scoile agus na dualgais ábhartha mar a ghabhann leis; tacú le mic léinn, meastóireacht a dhéanamh ar chuartheanna scoile, tuairiscí a scríobh. Cuirfidh sé/sí go mór le dearadh, forbairt agus bainistiú ar chlár don todhchaí mar aon le forbairtí eile i réimse Theagasc na Gaeilge. Mar chuid d'fhoireann Theagasc na Gaeilge, oibreoidh an té a cheapfar go dlúth lena c(h)omhghleacaithe sa Scoil agus sa Dámh le cur chun cinn comhtháthú na Gaeilge i gclár na hInstitiúide. Beifear ag súil go dtabharfaidh an t-iarrthóir faoi mhaoirseacht ar thráchtas fochéime agus iarchéime, cuairteanna ar mhic léinn ar shocrúcháin Ghaeltachta, agus go gcuirfidh an t-iarrthóir le ranganna teagasc agus le múineadh níos leithne na hInstitiúide ar iarratas ón gCeann Scoile.

## Taighde

Beidh an t-iarrthóir rathúil tiomanta don taighde agus don fhoilseachán ar ardchaighdeán i réimse Theagasc na Gaeilge ar bhonn indibhidiúil agus comhoibríoch. Is ionad barr feabhais i dtaighde an oideachais í Institiúid Oideachais DCU agus chuige sin beifear ag súil go mbeidh sé/sí gníomhach sa taighde ina réimse féin agus i réimse an oideachais tosaigh do mhúinteoirí agus go gcuirfidh sé/sí le tionscail taighde le Scoil na Teanga, na Litearthachta agus an Oideachas Luath-Óige; SEALBHÚ: Lárionad Taighde DCU um Fhoghlaim agus Teagasc na Gaeilge; agus leis an dámh níos leithne. Cuirfidh sé/sí leis an scoláireacht agus le saol acadúil na hOllscoile trí fhorbairt chlár taighde Institiúid Oideachais DCU.

## Rannpháirtíocht

Tabharfaidh an t-iarrthóir rathúil faoi riarachán ar ghníomhaíochtaí a bhaineann le Scoil na Teanga, na Litearthachta agus an Oideachas Luath-Óige. Beidh na gníomhaíochtaí seo sainmhínithe ag an gCeann Scoile agus is féidir go gcuimseofar rannpháirtíocht i gcruinnithe scoile, chlár, ionadaíocht thar cheann na scoile agus na hollscoile i margaíocht agus earcaíocht mac léinn. Maidir leis an té a cheapfar, beifear ag súil le go mbeidh sé/sí rannpháirteach san eagrúchán do chomhdhála agus seimineáir mar aon le deiseanna comhpháirtíochta a fhorbairt le páirtithe leasmhara ábhartha san ollscoil agus in earnáil an oideachais trí chéile.

**Assistant Professor in Teagasc na Gaeilge**

The School of Language, Literacy and Early Childhood Education is seeking to recruit an Assistant Professor to work collaboratively as a member of the Teagasc na Gaeilge team. The successful candidate will have a strong background in language learning, curriculum and pedagogy in relation to Teagasc na Gaeilge, and a minimum of three years' relevant experience at primary/post-primary level. Applicants for the post must hold a post-graduate qualification in Education in areas related to Teagasc na Gaeilge, preferably at doctoral level and have excellent Irish language skills. Experience in teacher education is highly desirable. The candidate will have strong interpersonal and collaborative skills, excellent administrative and organisation skills and demonstrate capacity to integrate ICT into the teaching of Teagasc na Gaeilge. The position is subject to the candidate being Garda Vetted.

**Teaching**

The candidate will be required to contribute significantly to the development, teaching, assessment and administration across a range of undergraduate and postgraduate programmes at primary and post-primary levels. This teaching will include module design and delivery and school placement including its attendant duties of supporting and evaluating students on school visits and writing reports. S/he will make a substantial contribution to the design, development, and management of future programmes and other developments in the field of Teagasc na Gaeilge. As part of the Teagasc na Gaeilge team, the person will also work closely with colleagues in the School

and Faculty to promote the integration of Irish across programmes. In addition, the candidate is expected to supervise undergraduate and postgraduate theses, visit students on Gaeltacht placements, contribute to tutorials and to the wider teaching of the Institute as required by the Head of School.

### **Research**

The successful candidate will be committed to high-quality research and publication in the field of Teagasc na Gaeilge on an individual and a collaborative basis. The DCU Institute of Education is a centre of excellence in educational research and as such the candidate will be expected to be research-active in their field and in the general field of teacher education and to contribute to, develop and support research initiatives with the School of Language, Literacy and Early Childhood Education; in SEALBHÚ: DCU Research Centre for the Learning and Teaching of Irish; and the wider faculty. They will contribute to the scholarship and intellectual life of the University, contributing to the development of the DCU Institute of Education's research agenda.

### **Engagement**

The successful candidate will undertake administrative functions related to the activities of the School of Language, Literacy and Early Childhood Education. These activities defined by the Head of School may include participating in school and university meetings, engaging in meetings related to programmes, representing the School in marketing and recruitment of students. The appointee will be expected to be active in organisation of seminars and conferences and in developing relationships with stakeholders across the University and in the education sector more generally,
