Réamhrá

Institiúid dinimiciúil dlúth-thaighde is ea DCU (www.dcu.ie) a mbaineann gné ilrémseach dhomhanda léi agus aithnítear í as caighdeán agus tionchar a cuid céimithe, mar aon lena plé leis an léann chun leasa na sochaí agus an gheilleagair. Cuirtear oiliúint an-mhaith ar a cuid mac léinn trí oideachas ardchaigheáin iomlánaíoch atá in oiriúint do dhúshláin agus deiseanna an 21ú haois a chur ar fail dóibh le go bhfeidhmeoidh siad go rathúil sa saol agus sa láthair oibre. Mar Ollscoil Fiontraíochta na hÉireann, baineann an nuálaíocht agus an fhiontraíocht go smior léi mar aon le teist mhaith a bheith uirthi as caidreamh éifeachtúil a thógáil le hearnáil na fiontraíochta, fiontair thráchtála, shoisialta agus chultúrtha san áireamh. Toisc feabhas a cuid gníomhaíochtaí oideachais agus taighde, baineann sí áit amach go leanúnach i rangú domhanda na n-ollscoileanna óga is fearr. Tá DCU san áireamh i measc an 50 ollscoil idirnáisiúnta is fearr atá faoi 50 bliain d'aois i rangú de chuid QS, '*Top 50 under 50*'.

Scoil dlúth-thaighde is ea Fiontar & Scoil na Gaeilge ina soláthraítear réimse clár ag leibhéal BA, MA agus PhD, agus ina ndírítear go láidir ar an teagasc, an taighde agus na daonnachtaí digiteacha. Is mian le DCU Léachtóir le Gnó a cheapadh ar chonradh buan ón 1 Meán Fómhair 2017. Ba cheart cáilíocht iarchéime chuí a bheith ag iarratasóirí. Cuirfear béim ar shaineolas sna réimsí seo a leanas agus an gearrliostú agus an roghnú deiridh ar bun: bainistíocht straitéiseach, dlí agus rialachas corparáideach, bainistíocht AD, ceannaireacht, nó réimsí eile cuí sa disciplín. Clár Ionchorpraithe DCU

Tugadh le chéile na disciplíní uilig mar aon le beagnach 200 ball foirne a bhain leis na Daonnachtaí agus na hEolaíochtaí Sóisialta in DCU, i gColáiste Phádraig agus in Institiúid Oideachais Mater Dei i ndámh mhéadaithe amháin, Dámh na nDaonnachtaí agus na nEolaíochtaí Sóisialta.

Fiontar & Scoil na Gaeilge

Scoil ildisciplíneach is ea Fiontar & Scoil na Gaeilge atá aitheanta go forleathan ar chaighdeán na gclár a sholáthraítear inti agus ar nuálacht an teagaisc agus an taighde atá ar bun ag an bhfoireann. Tá dhá chlár fochéime sa Scoil, BA Gnó agus Gaeilge agus BA Gaeilge agus Iriseoireacht; dhá chlár iarchéime teagaisc, MA i Léann na Gaeilge and MSc i nGnó agus i dTeicneolaíocht an Eolais, mar aon le clár PhD. Múineann baill foirne ar an gClár Comhonoracha BA laistigh de Dhámh na nDaonnachtaí agus na nEolaíochtaí Sóisialta, agus ar chlár an BEd agus ar an Máistreacht Ghairmiúil san Oideachas (Bunscolaíocht) in Institiúid Oideachais DCU. Beidh an t-iarrthóir rathúil ag teagasc modúil ghnó sa Scoil ag leibhéal fochéime agus iarchéime agus beifear ag súil go mbeidh ról aige/aici maidir le modúil agus cláir nua a dhearadh agus a

mhúineadh de réir mar is cuí. Bíonn an-deis ag iarrthóirí bheith ag teagasc laistigh dá réimse saineolais féin ar chlár na Scoile agus tá méadú ag teacht de réir a chéile ar líon na n-iarrthóirí PhD.
