Background & Role

The School of Language Literature and Early Childhood Education, in association with the Education Research Centre, successfully secured a tender from An Chomhairle um Oideachas Gaeltacht agus Gaelscolaíochta to conduct research on the Achievement and Attitudes of Students in all-Irish schools with DEIS status.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities

Reporting to his/her Principal Investigators, the Postdoctoral Researcher will:

- Conduct a specified programme of research under the supervision and direction of the Principal Investigators
- Support the Principal Investigators and research group in the design and development of the research programme
- Engage in the collection of data from pupils, parents and teachers in all-Irish schools with DEIS status
- Engage in analysis of qualitative and quantitative data using relevant software
- Write reports on the data analysis at the various stages of the project
- Engage in the dissemination of the results of the research in which he/she is engaged with the support of and under the supervision of the Principal Investigators

- Engage in appropriate training and development opportunities as required by the Principal Investigators, the School, or the University
- Liaise with both internal and external stakeholders including schools and academic partners/collaborators as necessary
- Assist with associated projects under the direction of the Principal Investigators
- Carry out administrative work associated with the programme of research as necessary

Minimum Criteria

Applicants should have a PhD in the area of education, preferably in the area of literacy. The successful candidate will have a high standard of spoken and written Irish. In addition, it is desirable that the candidate has experience in education in an Irish-medium and/or DEIS context.

Candidates will be assessed on the following competencies:

Discipline knowledge and Research skills – Demonstrates knowledge of a research discipline and the ability to conduct a specific programme of research within that discipline

Communicating Research – Demonstrates the ability to communicate their research with their peers and the wider research community (for example presenting at conferences and publishing research in relevant journals) and the potential to teach and tutor students
