	<ul> <li>Employer will communicate the outcome of the interview with the student</li> <li>If successful, the employer will arrange for a contract of employment to be sent to student</li> <li>If unsuccessful, you will enter back into the 'student pool' and the Programme Coordinator will try to match you with another opportunity, however this is not always guaranteed</li> </ul>

It is vital that you stay in contact with us and respond to any emails during your internship.</li> <li>Students will attend a final workshop once their internship has finished. The workshop will cover how to add your internship experience to your CV / LinkedIn and how to talk about your experience during an interview.</li> <li>*All students receive an AttW certificate upon completion of the</li> </ul>
