3.1 Credits for progression

Students must have successfully completed a minimum of 60 credits in a study period in order to progress into the second year of any available BEng in Engineering Undergraduate Programme, subject to the normal rules and regulations. In the event that a programme is oversubscribed places will be awarded based on academic performance.

Students may not transfer into a denominated Programme until they successfully obtained 60 credits, accepting circumstances as outlined in Point3.2.

3.2 Carrying of modules

Students will not be permitted to "carry" modules except in exceptional circumstances and subject to the approval of the Progression and Award Board and mode of delivery permitting.

4. Compensation

Compensation may apply, within the regulations specified in Marks and Standards.
