#### 1. Programme Specific Rules and Requirements

#### 1.1 Calculation for the Award Classification

To be eligible to graduate with the award of Graduate Certificate in the Internet of Things, candidates must pass <u>5 coreall three</u> 7.5 credit modules <u>on this programme</u>. with EE5xx codes and pass the 7.5 credit module OI501.

When calculating a candidate's precision mark, the weighted average of the <u>four core</u> <u>modules with three</u> EE5xx <u>codesmodules</u> is used. The core module OI501 is pass/fail.
