ABOUT CTYI

Designed to be intellectually stimulating, courses at CTYI are fast paced and cover material in more depth and at greater levels of complexity than is usual at school. Over 16 courses are on offer, many of which deal with topics not normally encountered in post primary school. Some of the courses on offer this summer are **Medicine, Law, Fiction Writing, Psychology** and many more!

Students choose one subject, which they study for 2 weeks (on either Session 1 or Session 2, dates below). Classes will take place between 10 and 3.30 Monday - Friday and after classes students can attend our optional activity programme!

To participate in the Summer Programmes at CTYI students must be aged between 12 and 16 years and must attend secondary school in Ireland.

Previous students have shown some of the following characteristics:

- Outstanding aptitude in either mathematical and/or verbal reasoning
- Previous standardised aptitude scores in the 95th percentile or above
- Excellent ability in written work and/or spoken vocabulary
- Exceptional interest in one particular area of knowledge or speciality
- Lively and original imagination
- Enjoys intellectual challenge and possesses an ability to work things out in their head

Please note all programmes at CTYI are conducted through the English language, so we recommend students only apply if they are confident reading and speaking in English.
