Ollscoil Chathair Bhaile Átha Cliath

Is ollscoil cheannródaíoch nuálach Eorpach í Ollscoil Chathair Bhaile Átha Cliath (OCBÁC). Tá bród orainn go bhfuilimid ar cheann de na hOllscoileanna Óga atá chun tosaigh ar leibhéal domhanda agus go bhfuilimid áirithe ar an 2% is fearr ar domhan. Tá OCBÁC aitheanta mar Ollscoil Tionchair na hÉireann, agus é mar mhisean againn ‘saol daoine agus an tsochaí a bhunathrú chun feabhas’ trí bhéim a chur ar dhul i ngleic le Dúshlán Dhomhanda i gcomhar le príomh-chomhpháirtithe náisiúnta agus idirnáisiúnta agus le páirtithe leasmhara.

Tá breis is 20,000 mac léinn ag freastal ar OCBÁC, agus iad i gcúig dhámh sna trí champus acadúla i gceantar Ghlas Naón-Dhroim Conrach i mBaile Átha Cliath Thuaidh. A bhuí lena cur chuige nuálach i leith an teagaisc agus na foghlama, fágann a seal san Ollscoil ‘lorg láidir ar na mic léinn’, rud a fhorbraíonn céimithe a mbíonn an-tóir orthu. Tá OCBÁC ag Uimh.1 in Éirinn faoi láthair maidir le Ráta Fostaíochta Céimithe, agus maidir le hioncam céimithe (an Phríomh-Oifig Staidrimh).

Is Ollscoil a chuireann béim láidir ar thaighde í OCBÁC agus tá roinnt ionad Taighde atá á maoiniú ag Fondúireacht Eolaíochta Éireann lonnaithe inti. Tá an Ollscoil rannphárteach i roinnt comhpháirtíochtaí taighde Eorpacha agus idirnáisiúnta. Is í OCBÁC an phríomh-ollscoil in Éirinn chomh maith maidir le haistriú teicneolaíochta faoi mar a léiríonn ceadúnú maoine intleachtúla.

Is institiúid ‘Tús Áite do Dhaoine’ í OCBÁC atá tiomanta do Comhionannas, d’Éagsúlacht agus d’lonchuimsiu - Ollscoil a chabhraíonn leis an bhfoireann agus le mic léinn ionas go mbeidh rath orthu. Tá an Ollscoil ar thus cadhnaíochta maidir lena cuid oibre chun rochtain ar oideachas a mhéadú, agus tá sí áirithe ar na 10 n-ollscoil is fearr ar domhan ó thaobh míchothromaíochtaí a laghdú i Rangú an Times ar Thionchar an Ardoideachais.

An Institiúid Oideachais

Is í Institiúid Oideachais OCBÁC an dámh is nuaí in Ollscoil Chathair Bhaile Átha Cliath. Tá sí lonnaithe i bhfoirgneamh saintógtha úrscothach ar Champas Phádraig OCBÁC i nDroim Conrach, Baile Átha Cliath. Bunaíodh an dámh in 2016, agus ba í an chéad dámh ollscoile oideachais in Éirinn í. Bhunaigh OCBÁC a cúigiú dámh, an ceann is nuaí fós, mar creideann sí go láidir go bhfuil sé ríthábhachtach staidéar agus taighde a dhéanamh i réimse an oideachais chomh maith le múinteoirí agus teagascóirí a ullmhú, agus tacáiocht a thabhairt dóibh, mar cabhraíonn na nithe seo le saol na ndaoine a athrú chun feabhas. Tá tuairim is 4,000 mac léinn ag freastal ar an Institiúid agus tá 3,500 díobh seo ar chláir a bhfuil baint láidir acu le socrúchán scoile.

Scoil na Teanga, na Litearthachta agus an Oideachais Luath-Óige

Tá Scoil na Teanga, na Litearthachta agus an Oideachais Luath-Óige ar cheann de na sé scoil de chuid Institiúid Oideachais OCBÁC. Tá baint lárnach ag an scoil le réimse leathan céimeanna agus cúrsaí eile san oideachas d'fhochéimithe agus d'iarchéimithe. Tugann sí dámh mhór fhuinniúil le chéile, baill foirne a bhfuil saineolas suntasach acu maidir le teoiric, cleachtas, taighde agus beartas i réimsí na Teanga, na Litearthachta agus an Oideachais Luath-Óige. Tá an fhoireann tiomanta do scoláireacht agus d'fhiúrúchán leanúnach i gcomhpháirtíocht chómhalartach le suíomhanna an oideachais luath-óige agus le suíomhanna cúram luath-óige, le scoileanna, le comhghleacaithe ar fud na hInstitiúide agus le páirtithe leasmhara eile sa chóras oideachais.

Próifíl an Róil: Ollamh Cúnta san Oideachas (Teagasc na Gaeilge)

Tá Scoil na Teanga, na Litearthachta agus an Oideachais Luath-Óige ag iarraidh Ollamh Cúnta a earcú le bheith i gceannas ar an gclár oideachais do mhúinteoirí iar-bhunscoile, is é sin Baitsiléir Oideachais sa Ghaeilge, agus sa Fhraincis nó sa Ghearmáinis nó sa Spáinnis, agus le bheith ag obair i gcomhpháirt leis an bhfoireann ag tacú agus ag cur le réimse clár oideachais múinteoireachta trasna na hInstitiúide Oideachais. Tá an post seo lonnaithe ar Champus Phádraig OCBÁC agus beidh an té a cheapfar freagrach don Cheann Scoile.

Teagasc agus Foghlaim

Beidh de dhualgas ar an té a cheapfar ionchur suntasach a bheith aige/aice i bhforbairt, i dteagasc, i measúnú agus i riarrachán maidir le réimse leathan clár fochéime agus iarchéime, lena n-áirítear:

- dearadh modúl, forbairt agus soláthar,
- tacaíocht a thabhairt do mhic léinn agus meastóireacht a dhéanamh orthu maidir le socrúcháin ghairmiúla agus tuairiscí a scríobh,
- cláir nua agus forbairtí eile a dhearadh, a fhorbairt agus a bhainistiú amach anseo i réimse Theagasc na Gaeilge ,
- a bheith ag obair go dlúth le comhghleacaithe sa Scoil agus sa Dámh chun comhtháthú na Gaeilge sna cláir uile a chur chun cinn,
- maoirseacht a dhéanamh ar thráchtas fochéime agus iarchéime,
- cuairteanna a thabhairt ar mhic léinn atá ar shocrúcháin Gaeltachta
- ionchur i ranganna teagaisc agus sa teagasc i gcoitinne san Institiúid de réir mar a éilíonn an Ceann Scoile.

Taighde agus Scoláireacht

Beidh an t-iarrthóir rathúil tiomanta do thaighde agus d'fhoiliú ar ardchaighdeán a dhéanamh ar bhonn aonair nó i gcomhar le daoine eile i réimsí Theagasc na Gaeilge. Beifear ag súil leis an méid seo a leanas ón iarrthóir rathúil:

- díogrammach ó thaobh taighde de ina réimse féin agus i réimse oideachais múinteoirí i gcoitinne,
- tionscnaimh thaighde a fhorbairt agus tacú leo i Scoil na Teanga, na Litearthachta agus an Oideachais Luath-Óige; in SEALBHÚ: Láirionad Taighde OCBÁC um Fhoghlaim agus Teagasc na Gaeilge, agus sa dámh i gcoitinne,
- cur le saol intleachtúil agus scoláireachta na hOllscoile, trí ionchur a bheith aige/aici i bhforbairt cláir oibre taighde d'Institiúid Oideachais OCBÁC

Seirbhís agus Ionchur don Ollscoil agus don tSochaí

Leagann an Ceann Scoile gníomhaíochtaí amach lena n-áirítear:

- páirt a ghlacadh i gcruiinnithe scoile agus ollscoile,
- páirt a ghlacadh i gcruiinnithe a bhaineann le cláir,
- obair ar son na Scoile maidir le mic léinn nua a mhealladh,
- a bheith gníomhach i seimineáir agus comhdhálacha a reáchtáil agus i gcaidrimh a fhorbairt le páirtithe leasmhara ar fud na hOllscoile agus san earnáil oideachais i gcoitinne.

Tabharfaidh an t-iarrthóir rathúil faoi fheidhmeanna riarrachán a bhaineann le gníomhaíochtaí Scoil na Teanga, na Litearthachta agus an Oideachais Luath-Óige.

The successful individual will be required to contribute significantly to the development, teaching, assessment and administration across a range of undergraduate and postgraduate programmes at to include:

- module design, development and delivery,
- Supporting and evaluating students on school placement visits and writing reports,
- contribute to the design, development, and management of future programmes and other developments in the field of Teagasc na Gaeilge,
- work closely with colleagues in the School and Faculty to promote the integration of Irish across programmes,
- supervising undergraduate and postgraduate theses,
- visiting students on Gaeltacht placements,
- contributing to tutorials and to the wider teaching of the Institute as required by the Head of School.

Research and Scholarship

The successful individual will be committed to high-quality research and publication on an individual and a collaborative basis in the fields of Teagasc na Gaeilge on an individual and collaborative basis
The successful candidate will be expected to:

- be research-active in their field and in the general field of teacher education,
- develop and support research initiatives within the School of Language, Literacy and Early Childhood Education; in SEALBHÚ: DCU Research Centre for the Learning and Teaching of Irish; and the wider faculty,
