Daft.ie June 2020 Report

Rental Supply in Dublin is up 63% 2751 - Noticeably higher than a year ago – with over 2700 homes on the market on July 1st this year. Average rent for June 2020 was €2,023. Further decreases in Dublin – Compared to March, when rents were at their highest level this year so far, rents are now 1.2% lower nationwide but 2.4% lower in Dublin.
