All applicants are required to then print and have the application form signed by their institutional/ departmental exchange coordinator before submission by email to DCU at exchange@dcu.ie **Deadlines:** Semester 1 and Full Year Applications Closing Date (September entry): April 30th 2021 Semester 2 Applications Closing Date (January entry): September 30th 2021 Module The Maximum number of credits permitted per Semester is 30 credits. Choices/ Students must select a minimum of 80% of their module credits in the subject area Learning of the signed Bilateral Exchange Agreement. Agreements DCU may offer incoming students the option to choose a maximum of 20% of module credits from outside their subject, providing these modules are available to incoming students. However, a number of restrictions apply and applicants are advised to research their choices carefully before completion of the section on Module Choices (and the Learning Agreement for Erasmus students). Applicants should also ensure that credits for their chosen courses will transfer back to the home institution. An indicative list of courses will be made available to nominated students at Application stage. Accommodation Incoming students are expected to find accommodation independently.
