Fee Assessments are conducted in Dublin City University by the **Fee Status Assessment Committee**. We regret that it is not possible to complete an assessment by phone, in person or general email correspondence.

- 1. Applicants must have a Full Offer from Dublin City University prior to the assessment to determine the fee status.
- 2. Applicants must gather copies of original documentation (as specified overleaf) to support their application and send by email to feestatus.assessment@dcu.ie (please note: applicants may be requested to provide certified hard copies of their applications at a later stage)
- Complete applications will be processed within 2 weeks of receipt of the application and relevant documentation.
 Candidates will be notified of the outcome by email. This email should be retained and presented to the Registry at the time of registration.
- 4. Incomplete applications cannot be processed; applicants may be contacted and requested to submit any additional documentation where required. DCU is not responsible for delays in the fee assessment process if an applicant provides incomplete applications.

Entitlement to free fees for non-EEA nationals who acquire EEA citizenship during the course of their third level studies with effect as announced by the HEA on the 1st of August 2013, a 'Change of Nationality' clause will form part of the Free Fees Schemes. As is currently the case students, who do not meet the nationality criteria of the scheme, will continue to be ineligible for free fees, however if such students subsequently acquire EEA citizenship during their third level studies they may be entitled to free tuition fees for the remainder of their course of study as follows:

- Students who acquire EEA citizenship up to **30**th **of September** in an academic year may be entitled to free tuition fees **for the full academic year**.
- Students who acquire EEA citizenship up to **31**st **January** in an academic year may be entitled to free tuition fees from the **second half of the academic year**.
- Students who acquire EEA citizenship from 1st February may be entitled to free tuition fees from the commencement of the next academic year.

In order to be eligible under this 'Change of Nationality' clause students must have met all other criterion of the Free Fees Schemes, apart from nationality, at date of entry to their course of study.

To qualify for EU fees¹, you must satisfy the following tests which are:

- The Nationality Test²
- The Residency Test

Applicants for **undergraduate programmes** must meet the additional '**Previous Study' criteria** to be eligible for 'free fees'. If you have been accepted for a full-time undergraduate programme, please answer question 3 on this form.
