Talent Search Eligibility

To be eligible to participate in the Talent Search, students must be aged between 12 and 16 years and must attend secondary school in Ireland. Previous talent search qualifiers have shown some of the following characteristics:

- Outstanding aptitude in either mathematical and/or verbal reasoning
- Previous standardised aptitude scores in the 95th percentile or above
- Excellent ability in written work and/or spoken vocabulary
- Exceptional interest in one particular area of knowledge or specialty

Students from countries other than Ireland who wish to establish eligibility for CTYI should contact CTYI directly.

Talent Search Participants

Students reaching an age dependent standard are invited to take part in academic programmes at CTYI (95th percentile) or CAT (85th-94th percentile). DCU Summer Scholars is available to everyone who participates in the Talent Search.

Over 30 subject areas are offered, including subjects as diverse as Popular Fiction, Criminology, Psychology, Computer Gaming and Engineering. These challenging courses are designed to provide heightened academic stimulation. They also provide an opportunity for students to meet other young people with similar interests.

Scholarships are awarded each year to candidates on the basis of merit and need. Please note, scholarships may only be awarded to the same prize winner for no more than two years.

All Centres are contingent on minimum numbers, so there is a chance that you may not be allocated to your chosen test Centre. In this instance, we will allocate you to your nearest available Centre. Applications must be received by the closing dates stated. Applications received on or after the deadline stated will be transferred to the next available date in the same or nearest test centre.

Participants may also sign up to our Correspondence courses and the Early University Entrance programme for Transition Year students.

Applicants with a Psychological Assessment

Students who have been assessed independently by an Educational Psychologist may submit a report by post for consideration, in lieu of sitting the Talent Search Assessment. Applications with psychological reports can be sent between the 1st September and 30th April.

Applicants should forward a copy of their psychological assessment along with a completed application form and the €60 evaluation fee. (CTYI do not carry out psychological assessments).
