

## Funding Rules for Teacher/Staff Mobility

Under the Erasmus+ Programme the following funding criteria apply and the amount awarded will depend on the following elements:

- 1. Duration of mobility period
- 2. Previous awards under Erasmus+ (preference will be given to staff who have not previously received funding under this programme)
- 3. The total allocation received each year by DCU for Teacher/Staff Mobility.

Please note beneficiaries must carry out their mobility in any Programme Country different from the country of the sending institution and country of residence.

## Grant Support for the Mobility of Teacher/Staff

Staff will receive an EU grant as a contribution to their costs for travel and subsistence during the period abroad. Costs are calculated under 2 headings: Travel & Individual support (subsistence). Please refer to both tables below to calculate the appropriate travel and subsistence rates based on distance travelled and duration of mobility.
