By applying to the DCU Study Abroad Programme, you will be required to provide DCU with certain personal data, including your name, address, phone number and other details set out on the application form. This is necessary in connection with the DCU International Office's assessment and administration of your application, and if successful, for participation in the Study Abroad Programme. Such disclosure of personal data is undertaken by DCU: (i) pursuant to its statutory functions under the University Acts to collaborate with educational and other institutions both within and outside the State; and (ii) to take steps prior your registration with the host university/institution.

Accordingly, DCU may disclose certain personal data to the relevant Partners / Partner Universities in the Study Abroad Programme in order to enable them to consider your application and to facilitate registration and completion of the programme with those institutions. Once your personal data has been disclosed to the Partner Universities, that institution will act as the data controller of the data for the purposes of the GDPR. The personal data disclosed to the Partner Universities by DCU may include the personal data provided by you on this application form, which in particular includes:

- Name; Date of Birth; Place of Birth/Nationality; Gender;
- Passport Number, photograph; birth certificate or passport copy (for VISA and related reasons);
- Programme of Study; academic references; and academic transcripts; and
- Email address and contact details and name and contact details of emergency contacts.
