2. Please ensure that your application is complete and all necessary documents are enclosed. Incomplete applications cannot be processed.
3. **Students in the fall semester need to be aware of the assessment components that are required for each of their chosen modules. Semester 1 examinations take place every January, so Study Abroad students are advised to take modules that contain 100% continuous assessment in order to prevent having to return to DCU to sit examinations in January. Examinations take place on the DCU Campus**
4. It is highly advisable that you choose modules from the same year and programme. Choosing from different years/ programmes may result in class and examination timetable clashes. **Students are responsible for their own timetables and the University cannot change timetables to suit individual students.**
5. Apply early to avoid disappointment.
6. You will be notified of the outcome of your application within 3 weeks of your application

Data Protection Notice

This is necessary in connection with the DCU International Office’s assessment and administration of your application, and if successful, for participation in the Study Abroad Programme. Such disclosure of personal data is undertaken by DCU: (i) pursuant to its statutory functions under the University Acts to collaborate with educational and other institutions both within and outside the State; and (ii) to take steps prior your registration with the host university/institution.

Accordingly, DCU discloses certain personal data to the Partner Universities in the Study Abroad Programme in order to enable them to consider your application and to facilitate registration with those institutions. Once your personal data has been disclosed to the Partner Universities, that institution will act as the data controller of the data for the purposes of the GDPR. The personal data disclosed to the Partner Universities by DCU may include the personal data provided by you on this application form, which in particular includes:

- Name; Date of Birth; Place of Birth/Nationality; Gender;
- Passport Number, photograph; birth certificate or passport copy (for VISA and related reasons);
- Programme of Study; academic references; and academic transcripts; and
