1. Programme-specific Rules and Requirements

Year 3

For students registering for the first time in academic year 2014-15:
Year 1 has a contribution of 10% of the overall Year 3 weighting.
Year 2 has a contribution of 45% of the overall Year 3 weighting.
[Ref.: DCU M&S, Item 8.1.1].

For all other students Year 2 has a contribution of 40% of the overall Year 3 weighting. [Ref.: DCU M&S, Item 8.1.1]

2. Derogations from Marks & Standards

3. Progression

Students must have successfully completed a minimum of 60 credits in a study period in order to progress to the next study period. Under exceptional circumstances, and subject to the approval of the Progression and Award Board, students may be permitted to progress to the next year of study carrying 10 credits where the following criteria are met [Ref.: DCU M&S, Item 7.2.1]:

- 3.1 Should timetabling constraints prevent a student's participation in the carried module, the Programme Chair may allocate an alternative module or restrict the student's choice of optional modules.
- 3.2 The student will not be permitted in any circumstances to carry more than 10 credits into the following academic year.
- 3.3 In line with university regulations [Ref.: DCU M&S, Item 2.2.4], a student will not be permitted to register for more than 75 credits in any one academic session / year.
- 3.4 Module(s) that have already been carried forward, cannot be carried forward into a further academic year.
