BEng in Electronic and Computer Engineering

1. Programme-specific rules and requirements

The 3rd year precision mark is included in the award classification calculation at a weighting of 15%. [Ref.: DCU M&S 8.1.1]

Students will receive a mark for INTRA; however, INTRA has a weighting of zero, and consequently this mark will not contribute to the precision mark for third year [Ref.: DCU M&S 7.1.3].

Major options are made available in 4th year subject to student choice and resource provision. Major option topics may vary in response to perceived market needs and technological trends.

2. Derogations from Marks & Standards

Marks and Standards apply.

3. Progression

Students will not be permitted to 'carry' modules except in exceptional circumstances, and any such 'carrying' of modules shall be subject to the approval of the Progression and Award Board and mode of delivery permitting.

4. Compensation

Compensation is permitted for all undergraduate modules as per the rules laid down in Marks and Standards. [Ref.: DCU M&S 7.2.8].
